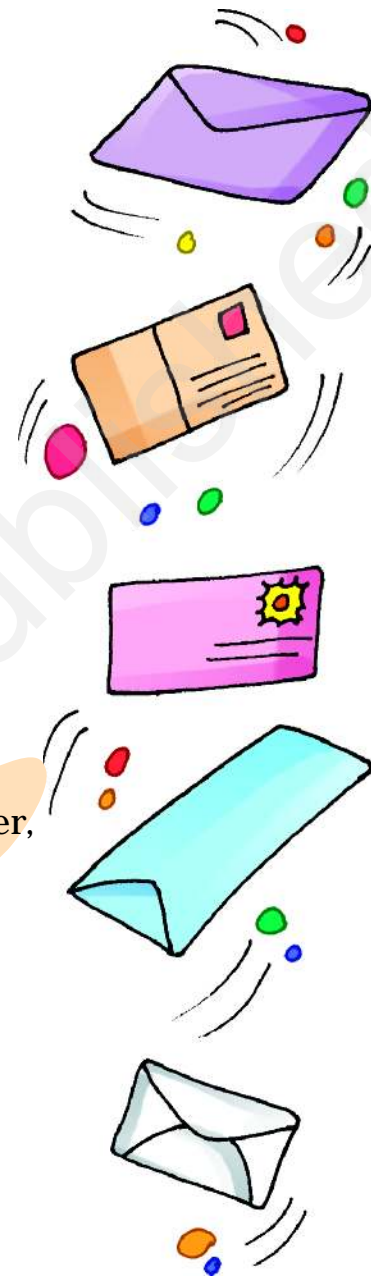
Have you ever received a letter? If you haven't, see what this child decides to do!
